PRECAUTIONS: – For more information consult safety data sheet.

- Do not allow the handrub to come into contact with the eyes.
- Do not mix the handrub with other substances.
- Do not drink!

- Avoid contamination of foodstuffs with the handrub.
- Store closed in original containers, in a dry, well ventilated area out of direct sunlight.
- Keep container tightly sealed and do not store with foodstuffs.
- Use the contents within 24 months of the date of manufacture.

RESPONSE:

IF SKIN IRRITATION OCCURS: Wash with soap and water.

IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing.

If eye irritation persists: Get medical advice/attention.

If SWALLOWED, give plenty of water to drink, call a DOCTOR if you feel unwell.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

PRODUCT IS READY TO USE FOR SANITISING OF HANDS, DO NOT DILUTE.

Before treatment, pre-clean visibly dirty hands with an appropriate detergent, rinse and dry. Efficacy of hand sanitiser will be compromised if hands are soiled.

Apply enough on clean hands to wet skin. Rub to spread over hands, covering all surfaces including nails. Allow to air dry. If skin is prone to irritation, the handrub can be rinsed off with water after exposure, and a moisturizer applied.
